



Local Partnerships/Outreach

We move people to Jesus by being generous and doing acts of service in the community with no strings attached. Our strategy is to be part of the everyday life of the city by partnering with existing organizations, working across denominational lines, and being available to serve the least, last, lost and lonely. We are constantly looking to expand our capacity for serving.

Besides our partnerships with those who don't call Move City Church home, we also empower those within our congregation to reach out in ministry teams through projects and events.

Here are some of the things we have going on regularly:

- **CareNet**
We stand with and support the local crisis pregnancy center.
- **Carmichael Elementary**
An elementary school in our neighborhood that we want to see thrive.
- **Discovery Forum Alliance (DFA)**
Ministers from churches around the area who work together in unity.
- **Egg-citing Family Day**
A yearly easter-themed family fun event with food, games, music and an enormous egg-hunt. We invite anyone from the neighborhood to come for free.
- **Father of Lights Festival**
A yearly event on October 31st that encourages Christians in the city to host a block party in their neighborhood. We partner with DFA churches to put on this event.
- **Freely Give, Freely Receive**
Donations of slightly used or new items are received and given away to the local neighborhood during an event that looks like a free yard sale.
- **Haven Health**
A group from the church visits monthly and provides activities and fellowship for residents who are receiving 24-hour nursing care.
- **Peaches Pantry**
Works to help stem hunger in Cochise County by providing food distribution to schools.
- **Precious Ones**
A non-profit focused on preventing the trafficking of minors in Cochise County, by intercepting those at risk and helping to provide a safe place for them to come.
- **Salvation Army**
A group from the church prepares, cooks, and serves a meal to anyone in the neighborhood. It is monthly, and anyone is invited to come alongside and help.
